## Environmental Policy Statement

ACD Services UK Ltd was incorporated in 2014, having originally been established as a sole trader in 1979, and provides a range of drainage services to a diverse customer base including industrial, commercial, retail, leisure and the general public. It is a family owned company based in West Mersea, Colchester and employs 7 people.

As a responsible company and employer the Directors of ACD Services UK Ltd are firmly committed to the prevention of pollution and the safeguarding of the environment and to providing a healthy and safe environment for everyone affected by the work carried out by the business

The Directors of ACD Services UK Ltd understand the importance of environmental issues and commits itself to work towards processes and practices that will have the least environmental impact on the environment, or where possible, that will add improvements to the environment. They will endeavour to comply with all legal and statutory regulations and requirements and will apply responsible standards, including approved practices from recognised agencies and trade organisations.

The Directors will pursue the objective of reducing emissions and fuel use.

Wastes attributable to the company will be recycled, reclaimed or re used wherever possible and IT systems will be developed to decrease the use of paper.

As an Environmental Agency registered operator in waste transfer and removal, all disposal activities carried out by ACD Services UK Ltd will be to certified and registered waste carriers/brokers via Environmental Agency licensed disposal sites

Suppliers to the ACD Services UK Ltd will be expected to meet acceptable environmental standards.


The policy is applicable to all aspects of the company including offices, sites, workshops, service activities and transport and covers all Directors and employees and all aspects of its work

The Directors of ACD Services UK Ltd are committed to developing management procedures to effectively maintain, monitor, and improve the effectiveness of its Environmental Policy Statement and are also committed to developing procedures that reflect the principles of external management system standards and that are subject to external assessment and monitoring

A copy of this policy has been given and discussed in detail with all employees.

Although the Managing Director has ultimate responsibility for Environmental issues, Elaine Mills as a Director, has been nominated by the three Directors of the company to be responsible for the day to day operations of the system. However it is agreed that all employees have a responsibility within their own areas of work to help ensure that the Environmental Policy is embedded within the whole of the company.

This policy is reviewed annually and the next policy review date is **1<sup>st</sup> January 2019**
